HOURS/DROP IN PLANS

Monday-Friday, 3-6pm

Drop In Pod Policy: Teens from both pods are welcome to attend all drop in sessions, since the local schools have chosen to allow pods to mix for sports. We will be enforcing rigorous hand hygiene and social distancing to keep everyone safe. If your teen is fully remote, please email cicilia@middteens.org to discuss an attendance plan that works for your family's needs.

Possible Drop In Changes: As the school year moves forward, Teen Center staff will gauge interest and need for additional drop in opportunities. Were this to take place, there would be a morning block each day of the week for that day's remote pod to come to the Teen center and complete their school work with teens from their pod. If enough remote families are interested in a separate session for remote teens only, we may be able to accommodate that as well. Please get in touch if you have any questions, suggestions, or concerns.

Parents/Guardians: In order to maintain the health and safety of our teens and Teen Center staff, no adults other than Teen Center staff and volunteers will be allowed to enter the building. **We ask that any parents/guardians keep distance from the doors to the building, and do not idle in the doorframe.** We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

HEALTH PRECAUTIONS

Daily Screening: Before being allowed to enter the building, each teen will be screened for symptoms related to Covid-19, for a high temperature, and will be required to sanitize their hands. The screening process will take place outside. If multiple teens are present they will need to keep proper distance from one another as they wait for their turn to be screened. The staff member performing the screenings will be required to wash their hands and put on gloves prior to screening. The forehead thermometer used will be sanitized after each individual use. All staff will be required to self screen at home at the start of each day.

Mask Policy: All staff and teens will be required to wear masks. While eating food, teens may remove their masks, but must remain at least six feet from others. After eating we ask that all teens either wash their hands or use hand sanitizer. While the weather and temperature allows, the main doors of the building will be left open, as to ensure proper air flow.

Disinfecting Procedure: All surfaces within the building will be disinfected prior to drop in hours and after teens leave for the day. This includes but is not limited to tables, counters, computers, chairs, door handles, door push bars, game equipment, etc. In addition to before and after drop in, the bathroom will be disinfected halfway through drop in. Disinfectant wipes will be provided and teens will be asked to help support our safety and wipe surfaces that they used during their time in the bathroom.
